Terry McCullough introduced the guest speaker Dr. I Nesch from Nesch, LLC. Dr. Nesch has 3 Doctorates. 2 in Physics (Sofia, Bulgaria and Moscow) and JD (Chicago).

Dr. Nesch discussed the Advanced X-Ray Imaging and the emerging technology. They are located out of the Purdue Tech Center in Crown Point. They bring technology to the Northwest Indiana area. They currently have exclusive licensing on 8 patents.

Dr. Nesch demonstrated that since the first X-Ray came out in 1895, there hasn't been drastic improvement. His company has advanced technology to pick up more from the X-Rays.

The advantages of his process are 90% reduction of radiation exposure, greatly improved contrast and resolution, more soft tissue visualization such as cartilage, tendons, etc. and ability to identify specific tissue. Their procedure helps to minimize the absorption, scattering and refraction of X-Rays, which allows much more detail.

He would like to see the technology advance and be available to ordinary people.

The images we saw are some of the first images out there. They are just starting to market to Researchers.
