As picnic attendees arrived they were treated with pontoon boat rides, safari bus rides, fishing, a yard toss game and strawberry or lemon daiquiris from a daiquiri machine provided by our vice president, Tom Donovan. Rotarians and guests also were treated to other liquid refreshments before dinner. Donations for daiquiris went to our Kenya water project.

After an invocation given by our president, Jim McNabney, everyone enjoyed a repast catered by Strack & Van Til's consisting of chicken, hamburgers and hot dogs with a variety of side dishes and desserts. After eating dinner, everyone witnessed a demonstration of water purification by Hans Enderlin and Tom Donovan. Two and one-half gallons of dirty water was taken from the Oesterle lake and treated with sachets that our club sends to Kenya to purify water.
