tional Research and is an expert in disaster preparedness. Dean repeatedly emphasized that the most important aspect of homeland security is the preparedness of the citizens. He cited 9/11 as the best examples of the importance of preparedness. While the Pentagon had an excellent emergency plan, the World Trade Center did not, and the result was additional casualties. However, Shearson Lehman was one tenant in the World Trade Center that was prepared, and he estimated that 2,400 lives may have been saved because of it. Dr. Larson urged everyone in attendance to make a commitment to preparedness by developing a family plan, and he suggested that the web site, ready.gov/America, was a great place to start.

Father Mike Maginot then concluded the event with a solemn benediction.
