## Meeting Notes From FEBRUARY 5, 2008

Guests included District Governor Jim Jeselnick, Munster Rotarian Ronjon Kinne (apologies for likely misspelling), Dennis Terry (guest of Mary Kaczka) and James Blackwood (from Tri-City Community Mental Health).

Phyllis Mamula cancelled her regular trivia quiz, which delighted many people and resulted in an increased number of "Happy Bucks" contributed by the members.

Our speaker was Kathy Clark, a new Rotary World Peace Fellowship recipient, who is from Fort Wayne. Kathy first became acquainted with Rotary as a member of the Group Study Exchange team to India in 2005. Mary Kaczka was "Capitan" of that team. Kathy is leaving Feb. 11 for 1-1/2 years in Australia at the University of Queensland in Brisbane.

The Rotary World Peace Fellowships are a relatively new program (6th entering class this year) dedicated to training promising graduate students with a career commitment to peace studies and conflict resolution. There are programs at 6 world universities, about 11 scholars at each, with students from 30 countries. The experience consists of 2 semesters of study, then 2-3 months of applied field work, and a final semester, with granting of a master's degree at completion.
