jackpot will be asked to take their winnings from the game rather than make an immediate donation. Subsequent donations would be welcome but absolutely not expected.

Rotarian Irma Torres-Cantu then introduced speaker Jane Gallagher, Reverse Mortgage Specialist at First Midwest Bank. Reverse mortgages are insured by HUD and offered to senior citizens age 62 or older who have paid off or nearly paid off the mortgages on their homes. Income requirements, debt ratio restrictions and poor credit ratings are not as important on reverse mortgages since the bank and borrower roles are reversed. The age of the client, value of the home and interest rate to be paid are all factors in determining the terms of the transaction. Today's going rate on reverse mortgages is 5.56%, and, by law, no loan can have a due date earlier than 50 years after the 100th birthday of the client. All reverse mortgages are non-recourse loans, and the clients will never owe more on their house than the value of the house when they leave it.
