This year's Rotary project will be local as explained by Judith Walker. Plans are for building a playground at the Hammond YMCA. Hammond Park District will join Rotary to raise funds to construct a playground. If the Rotary Club can raise \$7,500, the Hammond Parks will donate \$2,500. A few stipulations are that the equipment be available for use by everyone and that plans for maintenance and insurance are needed.

Mary Kaczka provided a Rotary Moment: The Rotary motto is Service Above Self, we can look back at Paul P. Harris who formed the world's first service club, the Rotary Club of Chicago in 1905. The Rotary Club celebrated its' centennial in 2005 and it continues to concern itself with truth, fairness, improved relations between peoples, and world peace. Today, its' members find ways to make contributions to their community by planning club, community and international service activities.

Milan Kruszynski, Port Authority and Marina Director was the guest speaker. Milan is a life-long resident of Hammond and has worked with many of the mayors over the years. Former Mayor McDermott Sr. had a vision to turn a beach into a thriving Marina and that is one of Milan's continued goals. Currently, Milan oversees the Marina with an expanded role of managing two parks, bike trails in North Hammond and the golf course. Over the past few years the Marina has changed. It went from having 1100 slips to 698 slips and then increased to 900 slips. Currently there are less than 50 slips available to rent which is a good thing! While the Marina continues to grow, an exciting \$8.5 million dollar clubhouse which will be open to the public is currently being built at Lost Marsh. Anticipated open date is October 1, 2009. Milan also is involved with the Festival of the Lakes, dinner cruises and all of the activities around all three lakes. While the full time staff is small with 24 full time employees, 200 summer kids are hired to help out during the busiest time of the year. As Marina and Port Authority Director, Milan's message is sustainability, economic development and to enhance and sustain the way of life for all residents.
