what is the most dangerous animal they have had to deal with and their response is the mosquito. Five children die every day from Malaria which can be spread by the bite of certain species of mosquitoes that carry the disease. Many of the villages had no running water and children lived in slum conditions. Villagers pull water out of the streams and rivers to use for drinking water. The goal is to get clean water into the villager's hands. Our Rotary donations of Pure packets have helped saved lives by providing clean water. The need for clean water to help battle disease is tremendous. The cost of one sachet of Pure is 5 cents. By providing Pure, it can make a difference in helping to prevent cholera. The ravages of aids, malaria and typhoid have killed many people and have left large numbers of children orphans. Christ's Hope International along with the Bells provides help and hope to children in an effort to make a difference in their lives. The Bells are thankful to have a partnership with Rotary and donated a beautiful chess set to help raise funds for the Water Project.
