Mary Kaczka then introduced our speaker, humorist and retired Professor of Economics Morton Marcus. Morton first defined the term recession for the group as a general decrease in the economy from a previous economic peak and surmised that the current recession is traveling a path along the bottom before the expected rebound. He also said that many people who believe we are in for a double dip recession create their own problems by not taking advantage of the rebound when it occurs, specifically citing those who wait too long to search for a job when the market starts to recover. Morton also stated that schools need to stop teaching students to pass tests just so they can graduate instead of concentrating on teaching the students to gain a meaningful education. Finally, Morton stressed the glaring need for an improvement in connectivity throughout the country in communities, shopping areas, schools and transportation systems.
