Dr. Pavey defined literacy as an individual's ability to read, write and speak English and to compute and solve problems at levels necessary to function in society. The Discovery Alliance supports Parents as Teachers, Boys and Girls Clubs, Adult Education programs and teacher training. It has been shown that children who are exposed to reading and writing develop literacy skills that pro-

mote lifelong learning. The agency services Lake, Porter and LaPorte counties and works with individuals from cradle to career.

By using ISTEP scores, programs are developed to ensure that children read at grade level by the third grade. There is a direct correlation between children's literacy rates and crime. What is the status of Literacy in NWI? Lake Count=52%, Porter County =34% and LaPorte County = 46%. 45% of the adult population has limited reading, writing and math skills. Within the next decade, there is an estimated shortage of 12 million skilled workers in the United States. This will affect the Manufacturing sector in Northwest Indiana. There are economic benefits to having a literate workforce: quality of work, retention, output of products to name a few. The community also is directly affected by having a literate population: higher wages and less poverty, decreased crime rate, improved school achievement and better quality of life.
