The cost will be five dollars. The organization has secured adults to help supervise and donations for the DJ. In addition, they have a process in place for students who want to attend from other Hammond schools. Several Rotarians did donate to the fundraiser.

Mary Kaczka introduced the speaker for the afternoon, Paul Wyatt. Paul is from the Indianapolis SBA office and has a degree in Banking and Finance and has served in the US Marine Corps. He presently works for the Small Business Administration in collections. Paul did a humorous job describing a very technical subject. He reviewed the basic rules for defining a small business and the regulations which his office works under. According to Paul a business is defined as a small business if it has less than \$5,000,000 in annual income and less than 500 employees. In addition, Paul stressed that the SBA does not loan money, that the agency guarantees up to 75% of the loan that is made through a local lending institution. In addition to reviewing the regulations, he expressed his frustration with all the constant changes the administration is making. He indicated that it was making it very difficult to inform clients when the program guidelines are constantly changing. He also gave some very humorous stories on how people defraud the government and tell on themselves.
