Meeting Notes From May 17, 2011

Hammond Rotary was proud to sponsor the annual Honor Scholars' Luncheon in Alumni Hall. We had a room full of the top 10 graduating seniors from the 5 Hammond high schools, plus school administrators, some parents and other community people.

President Chuck presided, and he included our usual Rotary starting procedures: the Pledge, an invocation by Rev. Bassam, and the 4-Way Test. We spared them by not singing anything.

After lunch was served, our own Nancy Machnikowski acted as mistress of ceremonies, making introductions of guests who included 2 Hammond School Board members, Debbie White (with husband Tom), and George Janiec. Lots of administrators and PTA members were there, also.

We were privileged to have entertainment by students from the new Academy of Performing Arts, located at Morton HS. For its initial year, the school had 800 applications, and chose 175 students. It opened in August 2010 featuring music, drama and dance. A boy and girl sang "It Takes Two" from "Hairspray", another couple did a scene from the play "A View from the Bridge," and 3 girls danced to "All That Jazz." Excellent performances all around, and Hammond should be proud of the talent they are developing. Artistic Director Greg Easton from the Academy introduced the students and recounted their successes in this first year of operation.

Dr. Walter Jenkins, Superintendent of Hammond Schools, presented his thanks for the program, and congratulated all the students.
