## Meeting Notes From NOVEMBER 27, 2007

Joint Meeting at the Munster Club, in the Performing Arts Center.

Our District Governor, James Jeselnick, introduced the District Governor from District 4160 in Mexico, Al Cipres. His farthest district is a 7 hour car ride. He has been involved with Rotary for 16 years, has been married 34 years and is an Architect who has had his own firm for 33 years. His firm has completed over 400 projects. He is also the Sub-Director for tourism for the Federal Government in Guana-juato, Mexico. He has 3 children and his club has 33 members.

Our District has assisted his District with water tanks. The community builds the base for the tank, Rotarians help to fund the actual tank and the federal government fills the tanks around once per week. This enables the villagers to have drinkable water. With the assistance of Rotary Clubs,

such as Schererville (who has donated \$500), they hope to get 8 – 10 more tanks this year.

Prior to getting the tanks, water was retrieved from rain through the downspouts and collected in old oil barrels. Once the community is able to have proper plumbing, they move the tank to the next community to allow drinkable water for those villagers.

We watched a video about the district and the impact the water tanks have had on the community.

His area is too dry for wells. The cost is approximately \$3000 per tank.
