Meeting Notes From NOVEMBER 6, 2007

Wayne State University. He has won several teaching awards including the Amoco Foundation Outstanding Teacher Award and the Central States Communication Association Young Teacher Award and the Central States Communication Young Teacher Award. His most recent publication is a 2nd edition textbook, *Communication: Embracing Difference*. It is co-authored with Lisa Goodnight, his former student and published by Allyn and Bacon in 2007. He has taught at The Harvard Summer Institute, in the summer of 2007.

Dean Dunn discusses basic communication skills and concepts. When communicating, people look for 2 basic things: a want for universal approval and the myth of perfection. When pressures of these concepts occur, behaviors begin to happen. Soon, you begin to see patterns. Duane reminded everyone to do their "civic duty" and vote today.

Terry McCullough introduced our guest speaker, Daniel M. Dunn, Executive Dean, Graduate School and Dean of School of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at Purdue University Calumet. He earned his B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. at Some people put up a "wall" when they interact with people. This is a non-verbal way of communicating. This is called "Distancing". We may label these people as "stuck up", but it could be that they are just scared of communicating. They are saying "don't get close to me".

Another non-verbal pattern is "Inconsistency". When the person says one thing, but their non-verbal actions say something else, the non-verbal behaviors are truer than the verbal.

Another pattern is the need to be "on" all of the time. Someone may try and draw attention to themselves all the time, trying to prove something. The perception is they are comfortable with themselves, but often times the opposite is true.

Another pattern is those that put down others all the time. They also use sarcasm to cover other issues. It's a form of self-protection.

What can we do with this information?

Don't internalize someone else's insecurities. It is not your fault they are acting and behaving this way.

If someone attacks you, they may just be attacking your "role" or position and not you, especially if they don't know you.

Go after concrete, measurable goals. Take small steps to succeed. (Cross country story)
