Meeting Notes From OCTOBER 16, 2007

Duane said that at next week's meeting **Jim Jeselnick** will be here at 11:00 am to discuss Rotary business and will be our Guest Speaker.

Bud gave an update on the water sachets. **David** and **Jennifer** are back in Kenya and presented the check to the local Rotary. They will soon be getting the funds back to purchase more sachets. The supply they have now is nearly exhausted. They are continuing to teach about the Pur usage and will get written reports from people to send to us. If everyone gave \$1 per week, we could raise \$1000 in a year.

Michelle Golden introduced our Guest Speakers from Camelot Community Care, **Phillip Golden** and **Joe Joyce**. They work with children that cannot remain in their parents' home. Around 90% of the foster homes licensed with them are in the Gary/Merrillville area. Currently they are working on improving their case management and clinical services as well as expanding into homes in Hammond, East Chicago, and south Lake County. They like to place children in homes in their current community, if possible. Annually, there are around 4000+ cases of abuse in Lake County. Their organization is one of a few that helps to place children in Foster Homes. They receive around 4-6 referrals from the Department of Child Services or Juvenile Courts each week.

They are currently recruiting therapists and case managers and are trying to upgrade what they provide to the kids. They have the notion that all kids should get the help and therapy that they need. They have a new Admissions Committee that helps to assess needs and place the kids.

They are looking for responsible and caring adults with the resources to be foster parents. They need to have the time. It is a big commitment. The child could be in their custody anywhere from one day to several years. They also need emergency homes where the child could be there from 1 day to 60 days. Also need homes with space for sibling groups of kids with 3 to 5 to 9 siblings to try and have them all live together.

Phillip worked for the Boys Home for 12 years. There is a difference between Foster care and residential care. Foster parents have to be very resilient. Some parents take children as an infant, and then at 2 or 3 years of age, if the parents are able, they can get their child back. This is very hard on the foster parents. They currently have 100 families. They are also looking for parents to foster to adopt. If the biological parent doesn't follow the judge's orders, they can lose their parental rights.

The goal set by the court is for the children to be returned to the biological parents. Camelot Community Care works with the parents through classes, therapy and other support. They try and help enable them to be better parents. They are state funded.
