out about a similar one in Iowa. The pantry is actually a converted beverage truck. The people that this pantry serves are the rural poor of America – many are farmers or work on farms to put food on our table but can't make ends meet for their own families. The pantry is supported but a group of Rotary clubs and they work in conjunction with the Ozarks Food Pantry which serves 20 thousand square miles and 29 counties. In their first year, the Rotary mobile food pantry distributed 250,000 pounds of goods.

Judith then reprised what our club does and who we serve – Dollars for Dictionaries serves all the 3rd graders in Hammond, our Christmas luncheon benefits Haven House, our golf outing this year benefitted the Y in Hammond. Jim Prisby then made a presentation from our most recent outing. We had a record number of golfers and sponsors this year and Jim put this together in record time too – it seemed. Jim presented Ed Salata from the Y with a check for \$4700 for playground equipment.
