As we discussed at our club assembly last Tuesday, a Rotary Service Day is scheduled for Saturday, October 2, 2010 for all Indiana Rotary clubs. Every club selects its own local service project. The project selected by Hammond Rotary is to provide desperately needed help for the food pantry operated by Northwest Family Services in Hammond.

Northwest Family Services provides childcare and food pantry services. The food pantry served 8,279 people in 2009. More than half were children. The food pantry generates no revenue and does not charge recipients. Anyone who comes is served based on documentation of family size and income level. They have recently seen an increase in the number of people needing food which they are not able to meet. They need our help. Northwest Family Services is a Lake Area United Way agency.

Every Hammond Rotarian is asked to purchase food for the pantry and deliver it on Saturday, October 2nd. Suggested items include canned goods, canned fruits and vegetables, soups, cereals, hamburger helper, and pancake mix. You
